



YEAR FOUR



In the last week we have been learning about the problems with Single Use plastic in Writing. We are creating persuasive texts to explain why we should stop using them.

We have also been practicing creating water colour art in the style of Monet. We learned how to colour wash a background and then use a range of brush strokes to give the impression of a tree . We used different shades and tones to show light and shadow.

In Maths we are looking at tenths, hundredths and how to divide numbers by 10 and 100. We have been looking at arrange of strategies we can use to do this efficiently.

We have been learning how to code in Computing and how to introduce ourselves and have a simple conversation in French.
