

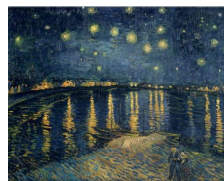

Topic—Earthquakes and Tsunamis

Over the last two weeks, we have explored the work of artists who have painted watery scenes. We looked at 'The Starry Night' by Vincent Van Gogh and 'The Great Wave' by Hokusai. The children shared what they liked about the pictures and what they didn't.

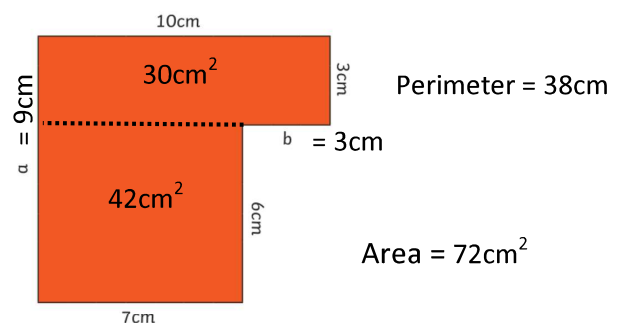
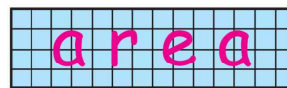


They then sketched their own versions of 'The Great Wave'. Using their water colours, they mixed appropriate colours to complete the pictures. Didn't they do well!



Maths

Over the last couple of weeks, the children have been learning to find the perimeter and area of rectilinear shapes. They have used their knowledge of times tables to help them.



English

As part of our topic on earthquakes and tsunamis, the children are learning to write newspaper reports.

They have each chosen the natural disaster they wish to write about. Some of the children are writing about true life events whereas others have chosen to create fictitious ones.

So far, we have looked at a variety of grammatical features as well as exploring levels of formality and emotive language.

Over the next week, the children will spend time drafting, editing and proofreading their reports before finally publishing their pieces for their chosen audience.
