In RSHE this half term, we will be learning about online safety. We will also be continuing with our anti-racism lessons where we will be looking at why representation matters.

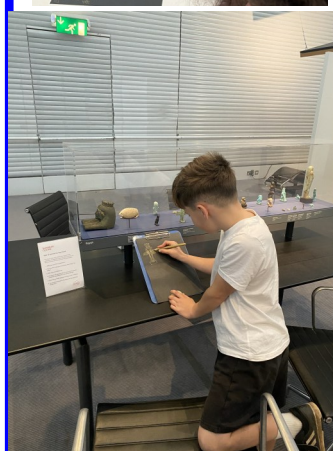
Revision
