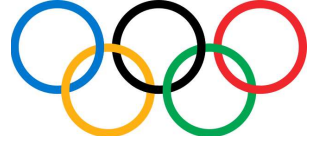




## Topic: How did the Ancient Greeks influence our world?

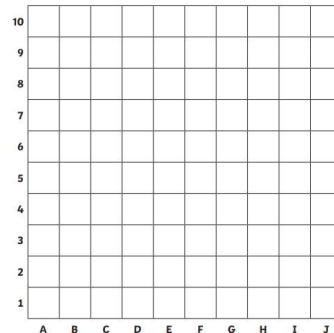
### English

Colouring Grid References

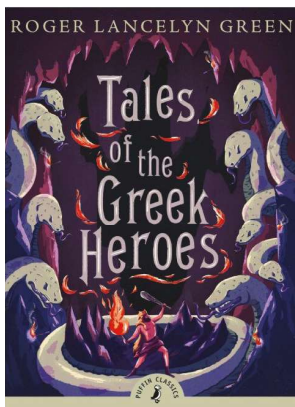


Colour each square the correct colour.
